This award is to help support talented mid-career women or under-represented gender or ethnic minority achieve academic promotion. The award(s) are open to all current ANMS members who are > 5 years post terminal training (postdoc or fellowship). Eligible ANMS members are invited to self-nominate. The award funds can be used to support salary or travel for a mini-sabbatical or professional development leave or bridge funding between grants to start or complete research projects. The recipient must attend the 2024 Annual ANMS meeting (July 26-28, 2024) in Baltimore, Maryland) to receive the award. The award will fund 1 grant for \$20,000.

- Attend 2024 ANMS Meeting (July 26-28, 2024) in Baltimore, Maryland)


